- 2022 – Largest art work in the world. Projection of a Tiger in Switzerland onto the mountain Eiger for the Year of the Tiger and the Winter Olympic Games in Beijing, China. Size of projection 5'300 m / 17'600 ft large and 2'200 m / 7'300 ft high.
- 2021 – Projections out from a helicopter onto the Eiger for the landing of the Mars Rover "Perseverance" of the NASA Mission.
- 2020 – Projections onto the Matterhorn mountain in Switzerland during March/April 2020 for the COVID-19 solidarity campaign for the world. Size of the picture 1'620 m x 1'620 m / 5'380 ft x 5'380 ft.
- 2016 – Placing Statue of Wilhelm Tell, Liberator of Switzerland, on the only privately owned island in New York.
- 2012 – Projection of the Titanic in original size onto a giant iceberg on the hour when the tragedy started 100 years ago. Projection took place where the iceberg originated who sunk the Titanic.
- 2006 – Jumping from springboard placed on icebergs in the arctic
- 2005 – Projection onto the Matterhorn Mountain by helicopters.
- 2003 – Projections realised out from helicopters, also in the Arctic.
- 1996 – 2003 Building up largest international military sports competition in the world for Special Forces; held in Switzerland.
- 1995 – Inventor of the world's first mobil Polo training pit.
- Projections onto icebergs, projections from boats and from helicopters.
- Projections onto Colosseum Rom, Pyramids of Gizeh, Parliament House of Switzerland in Bern, Kings Palaces, Cathedrals, National Monuments, natural Monuments and many other buildings or monuments.
- Several Light Art Expeditions to Antarctic, Arctic and into the desert.
